


#### WHERE

Faenza is a small city (roughly 60.000 inhabitants) but it's culturally quite active as it is a worldly center for artistic ceramics.

Geographically it is situated in the region

Emilia Romagna (in the province of Ravenna), and it is close to both the Appenninis mountains and the Adriatic see. It is very well connected by public transports to Bologna, Ravenna and also Firenze, very important Italian artistic cities.





# ACC OMM ODA TION

The accommodations of the volunteers are an apartment situated in Faenza city center (Corso Mazzini 37) or the guest house of the Contaminaion LAB (Via San Giovanni Bosco 1), also in city center. There will be double rooms (fully furnished), to be shared with another volunteer or a student of the same gender, and all the necessary facilities.

You will be given:


- accommodation (with all the utilities paid);

The activities will be equally divided into Learning and Volunteering, they will follow a learning by doing approach in the frame of non formal education.


- Italian language (online and offline)

There is a big difference between winter and summer in Italy.


In winter it can be quite cold (0-10 degrees) and very hot in summer (25-35).
